NO BUSINESS/COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL RUBBISH

ALL RUBBISH MUST BE OUT AT CURBSIDE BY 7:00 A. M. ON YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY.

*****RESIDENTS WHO BRING HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH TO A COMMON AREA***
(PRIVATE WAYS, ACCESS PATHS, COMMON DRIVEWAYS, UNACCEPTED ROADS, ETC.)**

MUST HAVE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER AND STREET CLEARLY MARKED ON TRASH BARREL.

NO BAGS WITHOUT STICKERS WILL BE COLLECTED.

ALL RESIDENTS USING RUBBISH BARRELS MUST HAVE COVERS ON THEM TO PREVENT RAIN/SNOW WATER BUILD UP INSIDE.

Please note the following list of items will **NOT** be picked up by the Sanitation Division:

Medical Waste or Mercury-Call Health Department-508-946-2408

- No rubbish in paper bags, unless they are placed in a receptacle.
- No containers/receptacles without handles.
- No containers larger than 55 gallons.
- No containers with sharp edges or bottoms.
- No ashes, dirt, stones or sheet rock.
- No metals, furniture or building materials.
- No carpet or fencing.
- No steel or nylon rope, chains, cables or slings.
- No leaves, grass clippings or brush.
- No animal waste, entrails or butchered animals, etc.
- No kitty litter.
- No motor vehicle parts.
- No hazardous waste; oil, paint, etc.
- No commercial/industrial waste.
- No vehicle tires.
- No recyclable material.

HOW TO PREPARE ITEMS FOR CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

Paper Products-Please cover both ends with plastic grocery bags to protect from rain and wind.

(Items below may be co-mingled)

Plastics - #1 through #7- **RINSE CLEAN.**

Cans-**RINSE CLEAN.**

Clear and colored glass-**RINSE CLEAN.**

NON-ACCEPTABLE GLASS:

Mirrors, automobile glass, light bulbs, clay flower pots, laboratory glass/crystal, ceramic cups or plates, window glass, heat resistant ovenware, drinking glasses opaque/milk glass, etched or frosted glass, no other color but brown and green. No broken glass.

PERMIT – FEES AND RULES

The Middleborough Board of Selectmen voted on June 13, 2005, to adopt and amend the Town of Middleborough Landfill Regulations as follows, effective June 13, 2005:

Landfill Location and Hours:

The Brook Street Landfill is located at 207 Plympton Street, just before the Plympton Town line. Hours of operation are **Monday through Saturday, 7:30 A. M. to 3:30 P. M., except Holidays.**

LEGAL HOLIDAYS (Landfill shall be closed)

Landfill Permits:

Landfill Permits are available at the Town Clerk's Office on the first floor of the Administrative Office Building located at the Eastern Savings Bank, 20 Center Street, Middleboro, MA, Monday through Friday, 8:45 A. M. to 5:00 P. M. Residential landfill permits are required to enter the landfill and must be presented to the Gate Attendant.

Residential Permits are \$25.00 per fiscal year which covers 12 visits to the landfill for that fiscal year. One landfill permit is issued per year. They **CAN NOT** be replaced. **PERMITS ARE VALID FROM JULY 1, TO JUNE 30.** Residents that exceed their twelve visits per year will be required to use the scale. Fees are below.

SCALE FEES

Scale fee is three cents (\$0.03) a pound with a minimum fee of five dollars (\$5.00).

IF UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES OCCUR AND THE SCALE IS NOT FUNCTIONING, THE FOLLOWING CHARGES WILL BE ASSESSED TO RESIDENTS:

Automobiles	\$ 35.00
Pick up trucks, cargo vans or trailers of equal size up to 1.0 ton	\$ 60.00
One ton dump trucks or equivalent size trailers up to 1.5 tons	\$ 90.00
Six wheel dump trucks or equivalent size trailers up to 2.5 tons	\$ 150.00
Ten wheel dump trucks or equivalent size trailers up to 5 tons	\$ 300.00

BULKY ITEMS:

Fees are charged for bulky items (i.e. T. V.'s, computers, furniture, appliances, tires, car batteries, propane tanks, etc.) taken to the Landfill. A fee schedule is attached. (See Page 6.) These fees are paid at the landfill and may be paid by cash or check.

Residents may bring the following items to the Landfill. A landfill permit **is** required but will **not** be punched for these items:

Concrete/Cement Pieces-No metal posts mixed in.
Blacktop.
Oil-No Limit.
Anti-freeze-No Limit.
Brush-Maximum size 3" (three inches) diameter.
Cat Litter.
Leaves, grass clippings, hay, manure.
Paint-**April 1st to October 31st Only.** (See Page 9.)

Residents may bring recyclable items to the Landfill Recycling Drop-Off Center. A landfill permit is **not** required for the following items:

Plastics - #1 through #7 (**NO CHILDREN'S TOYS**)
Cans-Tin, Aluminum
Glass-Clear, Brown or Green only-**No Frosted**
Fluorescent Bulbs
Rechargeable Batteries **Only**-Telephones, Cameras, Etc.

	<u>WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE</u>	<u>HOW TO PREPARE</u>	<u>DO NOT INCLUDE</u>
<u>LATEX PAINT:</u>	Interior and exterior latex paint. Water based paint tubes.	Keep in original container tightly sealed. Label contents if original label is illegible. Pack cans and/or tubes in carton or box.	No mixing paints. No packing in trash bags. No evaporated paint. No unmarked or illegible containers No pre-frozen paint. (Pop lid, let dry, place in trash.)
<u>OIL PAINT:</u>	Interior and exterior oil based oil based alkyd paint. Oil –based paint tubes. Solidified oil-based paint.	Keep in original container tightly sealed. Label contents if original label is illegible. Label if lead-based. Pack cans and/or tubes in carton or box.	No mixing paints. No packing in bags. No creosote. No unmarked or illegible containers.
<u>STAINS/VARNISH:</u>	Stain. Varnish. Lacquer Polyurethane Solidified stains, varnishes.	Keep in original container tightly sealed. Label contents if original label is illegible. Pack cans in carton or box.	No mixing stains/varnish. No packing in trash bags. No creosote, wood preservatives or bleach. No unmarked or illegible containers.
<u>PAINT THINNER:</u>	Usable thinner. Usable paint remover. Paint stripper. Polyurethane Linseed oil.	Keep in original container tightly sealed. Label contents if original label is illegible. Pack cans and bottles in carton or box.	No mixing paint remover, thinner or stripper. No packing in trash bags. No unmarked or illegible containers.
