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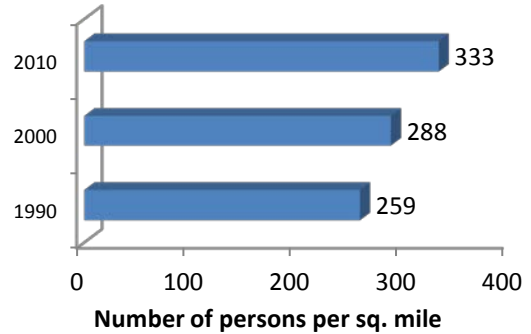

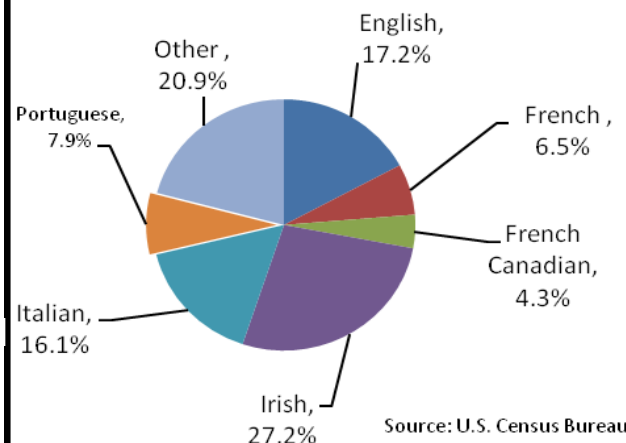

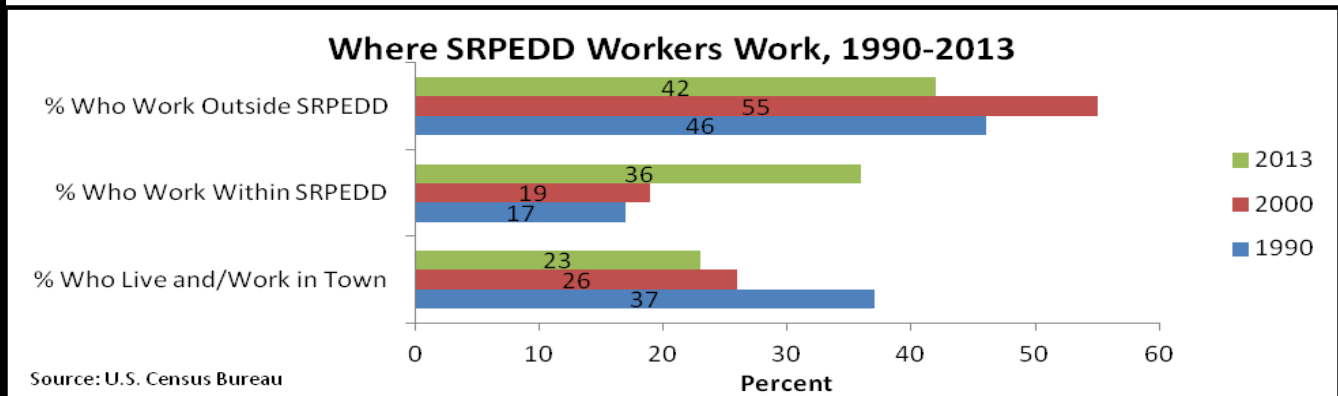

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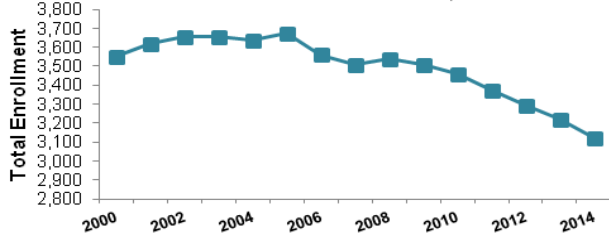

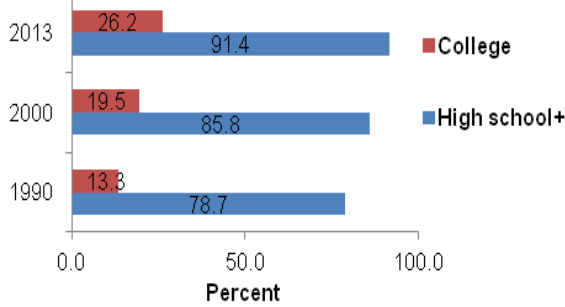

School Enrollment Trends, 2000-2014



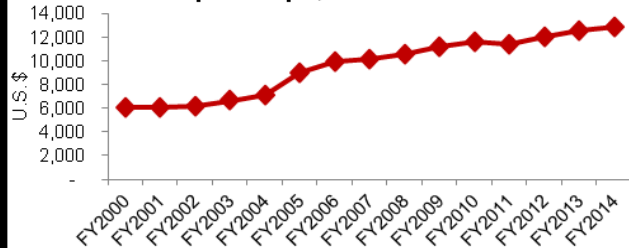

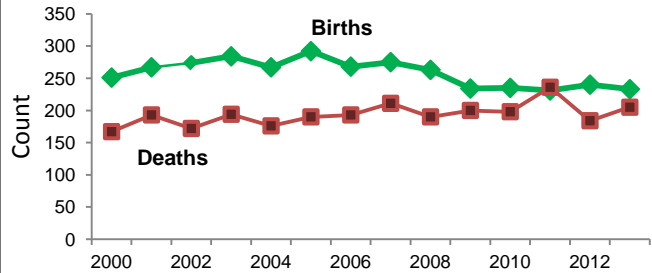
Cost per Pupil, FY 2000-2014

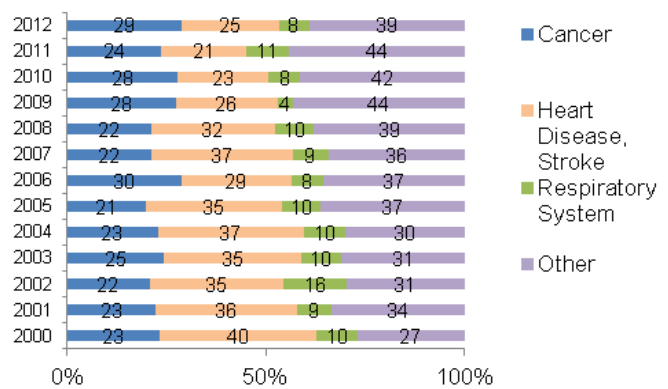

Number of Births & Deaths, 2000-2013



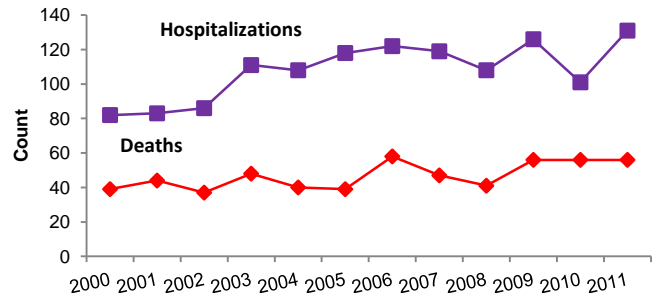

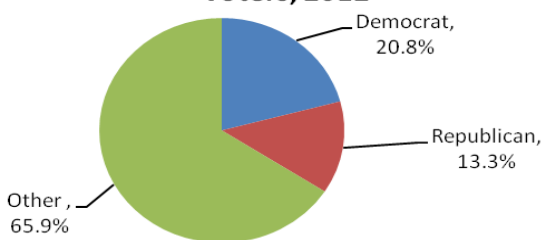
Cancer Mortality & Hospitalizations, 2000-2011

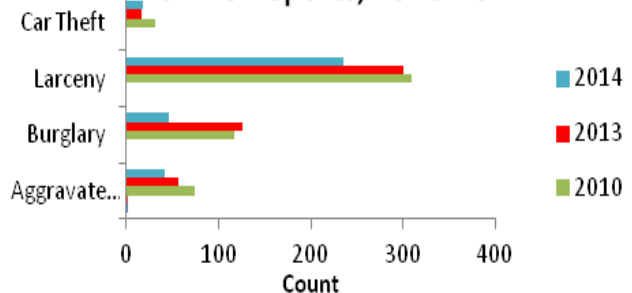
